OFFERED FIRST SESSION ONLY

1 Winners or Losers-

Who are the winners and who are the losers? This session will concentrate on how you can avoid beings a loser, following the Prophet (saws) **Aisha Muhammad- Presenter**

2. **KISS (Keep It Simple Sis)** Geared towards new Shahadahs and non-Muslims who still need to know the basics of Islam. There is no compulsion in religion. Truth stands clear from error.

3. Taqwa: The Aspiration of the Believer – Righteousness is the Muslim normal. We should all aspire to be as righteous as possible, and realize that it is more than a mindset, it involves action. The halaal and haraam do not change over time, and neither should we

C. Islaah Abd' al Rahim-Guest Presenter

4. Understanding Allah's Magnificence, His Perfection and His Attributes -

The goal of this session is to share the importance of memorizing the Attributes of Allah (Al Asma Ul Husna) and understanding their meanings. We will learn through our acts of worship how to implement their usage into our lives daily, thus getting to know Allah, Subhanahu wa taa'la, better and how to get closer to him and truly love Him, especially when we are calling on Him by his beautiful names, Insha'Allah.

OFFERED SECOND SESSION ONLY

1. **Got Deen?-** Discussing the correct understanding of the Deen and ways to strengthen our home life by instilling the values of Qur'an ad Sunnah in every room.

Aisha Muhammad- Guest Presenter

2. Follow the Leader Prophet Muhammad (saws); A Reminder Benefits the Believer.

When we take our Shahaadah and testify that there is no God but Allaah and that Muhammad ibn Abdullah (saws) is the last messenger and prophet of Allaah, we become Muslim with all the rights, duties and responsibilities that go along with that pledge. However, Allaah (swta) did not leave us to try and figure out what those rights, duties, and responsibilities are. HE, the All Merciful One, sent us a guide to help navigate the way back to HIM. HE created a living, breathing, thinking human being, like us, to show us through his sayings and actions, what Allaah demands from us; HE created Prophet Muhammad (saws). In shaa Allaah, this session will explore some of the halal and haram reminders that Prophet Muhammad (saws) left to help us on our journey back to Allaah (swta).

3. **CDC: Choices, Decisions, Consequences** – When each of us makes a decision to be Muslimah, striving to be a Mu'minah, the choices may be clear or blurred. What masjid should I attend? Who will be my teachers? What books will I read? Who will be my inspiration? Every choice leads to a decision, which leads to a consequence. This session will discuss what guidelines to use in making the correct Islamic choices.

4. **Don't Give Up the Fight, Never Surrender-In this session**, we will cite Quran and Sunnah to help us keep up the fight to maintain our deen in the face of unbelievably sanctioned adversity.

PRESENTERS

Aishah Muhammad-Mumin became Muslim in 1972 in Philadelphia on Columbia Ave at the Masjid that was part of the Darul Islam movement. Right after the shahaadah, she started right in with learning about her new way of life and has studied Arabic, Qur'an and fiqh under various imams in person and online. They include Imam Javed Baiyat of the Laurel Masjid, and Tajweed under Muhammad ar'Raee of the Noorani Qaida publications earning a certificate. Alhamdulillah, she is a former member the Women's Committee of Masjid as Saffat (WCMAS) and the Gwynn Oak Community and has assisted in teaching and caring for children in the Baltimore and Laurel area. She has earned a design degree from the University of Delaware enhancing her sewing and computer skills. Aishah resides in Philadelphia where she still studies Qur'an now online with Bayyinah Institute and still assists in teaching and caring for children while she makes garments for the Muslims.

Maisha Muhammad is an 11-year member of WCMAS although she has been a member of the Masjid As-Saffat community over 40 years. The mother of 7 children, 24 grandchildren, and 4 bonus grandchildren, Sister Maisha is a former elementary/middle school teacher. She has taught at the Islamic Community School of Masjid As-Saffat for 9 years and in the Baltimore City Public School System for 18 years. Maisha is a member of Sharikat An Nisaa, a business of 5 Muslim women. Ms. Muhammad has studied under Imam Taif Abdullah, Imam of Masjid As-Saffat. She has also studied tajweed and tafseer under Sister Umm Zakiyyah at Masjid Al Ihsan. Maisha has lived in Baltimore all of her life.

Taahirah Matin is a mother of 5, and grandmother of 3. She is a Baltimore native and spent 7 of her formative years in Saudi Arabia. She earned her Bachelor's of Science degree in Social Work from Morgan State University. She is currently a teacher at Islamic Community School, where she is also an alumna.







We used to know but we didn't act

Ibnul Qayyim (RA) said,

"A girl died of the plague and her father saw her in his dream. He said, 'my daughter, tell me about the hereafter. So she said, 'We've approached a serious matter. We used to know but we didn't act. I swear by Allah, to add one tasbeehah (saying Subhan Allah) or a single Rak'ah to my book of deeds is more beloved to me than the whole world and everything in it.'

This girl said words of great importance. 'We used to know but we didn't act', but many of us don't understand what she means.

We used to know, that if we say Subhan Allah wa bi Hamdihi 100 times our sins are forgiven even if they're like the foam of the sea (yet days and nights pass and we don't say it)

We used to know that two rak'ahs of Duha prayer is the equivalent of giving 360 charities (yet day after day pass and we don't pray it)

We used to know that a house in the middle of Januah is guaranteed for one who abandons lying even while joking (yet every second sentence we utter is a lie)

We used to know that fasting a day voluntarily for the sake of Allah puts a distance between our face and the fire the size of seven trenches and Allah distances our face from the fire the distance travelled in 70 years, (and we haven't fasted single day this week)

We used to know that whoever visits a sick person is followed by 70,000 angels seeking Allah's forgiveness on his behalf (but we haven't visited a sick person this week)

We used to know that whoever prayed a funeral prayer and followed it till it was buried has two Qiraats of reward and a Qiraat is like the mountain of Uhud (yet weeks pass and we haven't been to the graveyard.)

We used to know that whoever builds a mosque even if it's like a bird's nest Allah builds a house for them in paradise (yet we haven't contributed to the building of a Masjid, even with 10 dinars)

We used to know that the one who supports the widow and her children is like the fighter in the path of Allah and the one who fasts all day and prays all night without sleeping. (Yet we haven't contributed to sponsoring a widow and her children)

We used to know that whoever reads a single letter from the Quran has a good deed and every deed is multiplied by 10. Yet we haven't made a point to read it every day.

We used to know that an accepted Hajj has the reward of jannah and it sends the person who completed it off like the day his mother gave birth to him. (With a clean book of deeds) yet we haven't performed the rites of Hajj although our circumstances have made it easy for us.

We knew the honor of a believer is in Qiyam Al-layl, and that the Prophet (pbuh) and his companions never missed it all their lives despite being busy with making a living and fighting in the path of Allah and spreading the religion. But we have neglected this matter terribly.

We knew the Day of Judgment was coming without a doubt and that Allah will resurrect us from our graves but we haven't prepared for that day.

We used to bury the deceased and pray over them but haven't prepared ourselves for a day like this one, as if we have a guarantee that it won't happen to us.

We know that every breath we breathe is getting us closer to death yet we're still busy with amusement and playing. It's time we change the way we're living and prepare properly for the day of accounting.







